School Colour Explosion™ Run – Parent Consent

Thank you to all the students and families for your support with the School Colour Explosion™ Fundraiser back in Term 1. We were amazed at how successful we were at raising money for our P&C – \$10,329 in total, and were disappointed the day had to be postponed due to COVID19 restrictions. However, the good news is we are able to go ahead with the event with some modifications.

On **December 11th, 2020** all students will be participating in a special fun afternoon of sporting activities and team-building games. Classes will rotate around a selection of activities as well as partake in the Colour Explosion Fun Run in stage groups. As there are still restriction on parents being on the school grounds, we will be utilising all teachers and support staff on the day to make it an exciting and enjoyable experience. We will be publishing photos on social media for you to enjoy.

We previously sent home information on the Colour Explosion Fun Run and a permission note for those students who are unable to participate fully due to health concern. I apologise that we have to ask for you permission again due to the date changing. All measures have been taken to ensure that this event is safe for all students. As this is a normal school day and the fun run has been organised to be part of the school's fitness program, ALL students are expected to participate unless otherwise specified below.

There will be one colour powder station throughout the course and various water stations to wet the students. As students participate, they will be sprayed with a different coloured powder for each lap they run. Your child can still participate in the event should you not wish for them to be sprayed with coloured powder. If your child is not to be sprayed with powder, they are to wear a plain black t-shirt instead of white. Or they can wear a face mask and still participate as normal.

The staff will do their best to throw the powder at the torso, however wind and other factors can cause the powder to protrude on the face. All students will be supplied with a colourful pair of sunglasses to wear on the day which will prevent any powder accidentally entering their eyes. You may wish for your child to **bring their own face mask if necessary**.

The colour powder used in the event is non-toxic, biodegradable and environmentally friendly consisting of 98% corn starch and 2% food colouring. It will likely washout of your child's clothing, however we recommend that your child wears a plain white shirt that you don't mind being coloured. That's what the event is all about! Based on the toxicology profiles of the powders used, their concentrations in the formulation and the mode of use, the colour powder is considered safe for use. Students with lung issues such as asthma are advised to be careful in their decision to participate.
