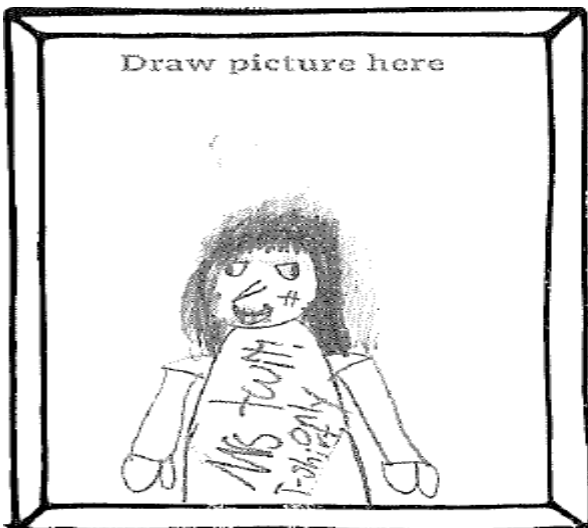
Appearance:
