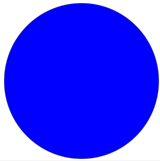

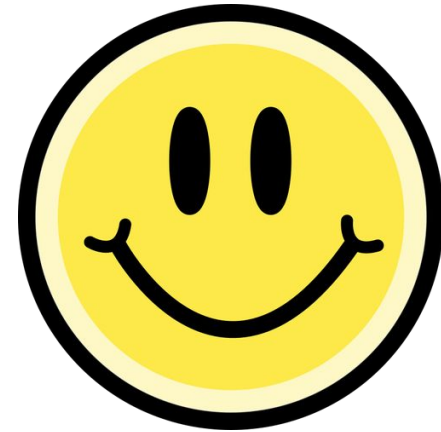


# Fun Facts About Me
