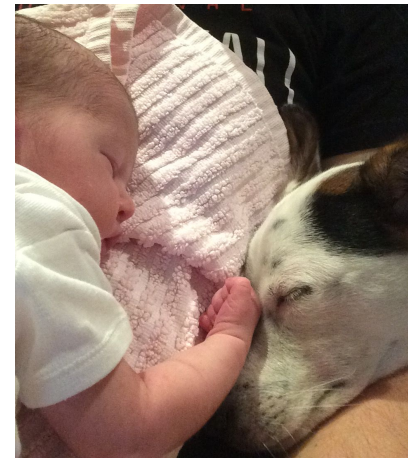


# Crazy Facts About Me
