I have two younger brothers who I took care of growing up, and now have a wonderful extended family whom I cherish.



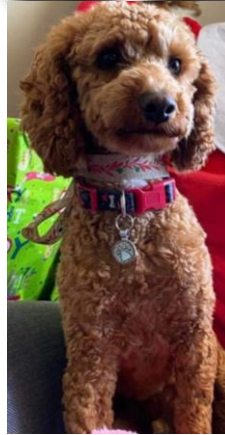
Nieces and Nephews

I love to find a lounge chair beside the pool or overlooking the ocean and read for hours and hours with a frozen mango mocktail.

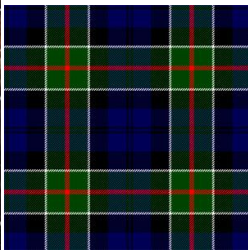


Best ever holiday

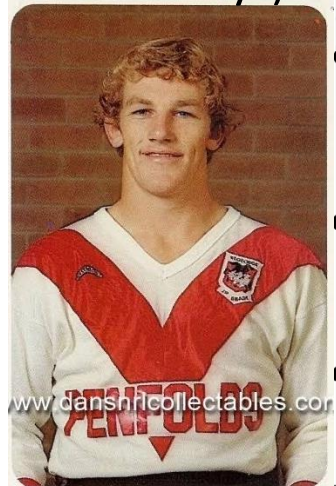
NRL Dragons

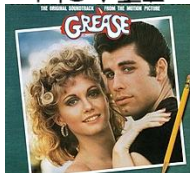

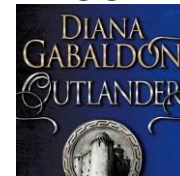
